27 New Testament books which are mainly occupied with the message of Divine Grace and the salvation which it brings	

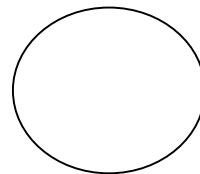

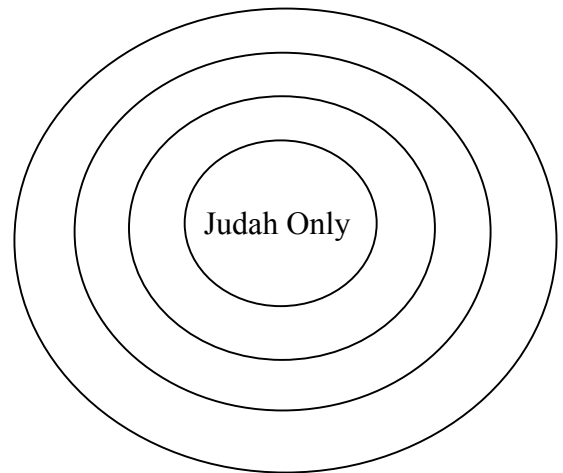
