Psalm 62: Trusting God in the Midst of Opposition

David models trust in God (Psalm 62:1-4)

1. True peace and strength are found only in the Lord (Psalm 62:1-2)
2. Trusting in the Lord does not exempt the believer from personal attacks and betrayal (Psalm 62:3-4)

David encourages trust in God (Psalm 62:5-8)

1. God provides safety, deliverance, and security in the midst of great turmoil (Psalm 62:5-7)
2. Believers are encouraged to trust in the Lord as they pour their hearts out to Him (Psalm 62:8)

David's appeal to trust in God (Psalm 62:9-12)

1. Man and all his works are temporary (Psalm 62:9-10)
2. Power and Loyal Love belong to the Lord, the Righteous Judge (Psalm 62:11-12)
