## Psalm 63: Alone in the Wilderness

- **His setting** — being misplaced in the Judean wilderness (Psalm 63:1a)
- **His yearning** — thirsting for his Creator in the wilderness (Psalm 63:1b)
- **His routine** — seeking the Lord at the Tabernacle (Psalm 63:2)
- **His recollection** — remembering that the Lord's loyal love is always operational (Psalm 63:3a)
- **His response** — magnifying the Lord as his abundant supply (Psalm 63:3b-6)
- **His repose** — entrusting his well-being to the Lord (Psalm 63:7-8)
- **His realization** — concluding that the Lord will support him and deal with their mutual enemies (Psalm 63:9-11)
