

DECLARATION OF PURPOSE

We, the undersigned Believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, do make this declaration of purpose:

That as of this date we do constitute ourselves a church--that is, a local assembly or expression of the Church, which is the body and bride of Christ, a spiritual organism made up of all born-again persons of this present age. The name of this church shall be selected by mutual consent at a later date.

That the purpose of this church is:

To stand unequivocally for the fundamentals of the Faith as contained in the Holy Scriptures;

To present the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ at home and abroad to those who have not accepted Him as their personal Savior;

To teach the Holy Scriptures for the edification of those who have accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Savior;

To minister to those among us who are in need;

To meet together for worship, for instruction, for fellowship, and for communion at the Lord's Table; and

To do all things in the name of and for the honor and glory of our Savior, the King of Kings, Lord of Lords, even Jesus Christ.
